M - MUST: Describes and idea or requirement that meets all of the evaluation criteria and/or must be met in the final solution for the solution to be considered a success.

S - SHOULD: Represents a high-priority idea or requirement that meets most of the criteria or should be included in the solution if it is possible. This is often a critical criterion but one which can be satisfied in other ways if strictly necessary.

C - COULD: Describes and idea or requirement which meets some of the evaluation criteria or is considered desirable but not necessary. This will be included if time and resources permit.

W – WOULD/WON'T: Represents an idea or requirement that stakeholders have agreed has potential to meet the evaluation criteria and will not be implemented at this time but may be considered for the future.
